EP AGnFERT Privacy Policy

1. INTRODUCTION

- 1.1. This is the Privacy Policy for the EP AGnFERT website located at <u>epagnfert.com.au</u> ("Site").
- 1.2. The data controller and owner/operator of this Site is EP AGnFERT Pty Ltd (ABN 93 609 140 801) of 94 Martin Tce, PO BOX 225 Kimba SA 5641.
- 1.3. Please read this Privacy Policy carefully as it explains in general terms how it protects the privacy of your personal information. By submitting your personal information to us you agree that we may use such information in accordance with this Privacy Policy.

2. HOW WE COLLECT YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION

- 2.1. We collect your personal information directly from you via the Site. For example, when you join our mailing list or when you sign up as a member of the Site. We may also collect certain information when you contact us including via phone and email.
- 2.2. The type of personal information we collect about you may include your name, e-mail address, postal address, birthday, phone number and other information about you.

3. OUR DISCLOSURE STATEMENT

- 3.1. When we collect your personal information, we will tell you why we are collecting it and how we plan to use it, or these things will be obvious when we collect your information.

4. HOW WE USE OR DISCLOSE YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION

- 4.1. We will use and disclose personal information for the primary purpose for which it was collected. Other uses of your personal information may include:

- 4.4. You have the right to ask us not to use your data for direct marketing at any stage. This request may be made by contacting us via troy@epagnfert.com.au. We will process your request within one calendar month of receiving it.
- 4.5. We may disclose your personal information in the following circumstances:
 - If we sell or buy any business assets (or the business itself) and are required to disclose personal information to prospective buyers or sellers;
 - If we are required by law to disclose such information;
 - If we need to use such information to enforce our Terms and Conditions, or to protect the rights, property or safety of ourselves or others.

5. USE OF AGGREGATE DATA

- 5.1. We may collect certain non-personal information to optimise the services we provide to you (for example the identity of your browser, the type of operating system you use, your IP address and the domain name of your service provider).
- 5.2. We may use and disclose non-personally identifiable information in aggregate form to improve the Site and our services and to assist our advertising partners with targeted advertising.

6. SECURITY

6.1. We strive to ensure the security, integrity and privacy of personally identifiable information of our Users. We use a variety of physical and electronic security measures including restricting physical access to our offices and firewalls and secure databases to keep personal information secure from misuse, loss or unauthorised use or disclosure. Although we use best efforts to maintain security of your information, unfortunately no data transmission over the Internet can be guaranteed to be totally secure and you acknowledge that we will not be liable in the event that your personal information is accessed or disclosed due to reasons beyond our control, including but not limited to hacking from a third party.

7. OPTING OUT

8.1. 9. COOKIES

9.1. Our Site may use 'cookies' which is when a website transfers certain data to an individual's hard drive for record-keeping purposes. They allow us to track usage patterns and to compile data that can help us improve our content and target advertising. If any of the personal information we hold about you is inaccurate, incomplete or out-of-date, please contact us immediately and we will update your record within one calendar month.

12. WITHDRAWING CONSENT
